
EASTER EGG HUNT

Supplies Needed: Printed cards, scissors, plastic eggs (if available)

Instructions:

- Print a copy of the cards in this packet. Younger kids cards have numbers in the upper left corner and older kids do not have numbers (to make it a little more challenging!).
- Cut out cards along dotted lines and fold cards in quarters.
- Insert cards into plastic eggs (use one color per child or write each child's name on their set of eggs so they only find the eggs with their name) and add a treat or coins to make the hunt more fun!
- Hide eggs.
- Gather the kids and let them know they are searching for the 12 parts of the Easter story. They are to find only the eggs of their color or the ones with their names on them.
- When each child finds all of their eggs, tell them to open them and try to put the story in order of events as they happened.
- Take it one step further...go to the Bible and look up each verse on each of the cards!
